1. The following Maxwell AFB and Columbus AFB Airman Leadership School class schedule is provided for your planning purposes.

2. To be eligible to attend ALS, Senior Airmen must have re-enlisted, have 36 months' time in service or be a SSgt select. In addition, they must meet Air Force fitness standards and have at least 6 months retainability from the graduation date.

3. Students are selected for ALS based on the following priority:

PRIORITY 1: SSgt without ALS, SSgt selects, SrA with 36 months or more TIS selected for deployments and short-tour/remote assignments

PRIORITY 2: SrA w/most TIG selected f/deployment or pending assignment.

PRIORITY 3: Eligible Air Force and Department of Defense civilians, sister service E-4s, approved international students and local civilians. Department of Defense civilians may take enlisted professional military education as consistent with the Air Force civilian development policy.

4. Once selected, attendance is mandatory. Only the unit commander can defer the Airman from attendance. Deferral of priority 1 or 2 Airmen is highly discouraged as this could place the individual in jeopardy of promotion withhold.
