

Laser Tag Arena Rules and Code of Conduct

General Rules:

- 1. Age and Height Requirements:**
 - Players must be at least 7 years old.
 - Minimum height requirement is 48 inches (4 feet).
- 2. Waiver Forms:**
 - All players must sign a waiver form. For players under 18, a parent or guardian must sign.
- 3. Game Duration:**
 - Each game lasts approximately 15-20 minutes.
- 4. Equipment:**
 - All players must wear the provided laser tag headband and use the provided laser tag gun.
 - Do not tamper with or modify the equipment.
- 5. Safety Gear:**
 - Closed-toe shoes are required.
 - No loose clothing or accessories that could cause tripping or get caught in equipment.

Safety Rules:

- 1. No Physical Contact:**
 - No running, pushing, shoving, or physical contact with other players.
 - Maintain a safe distance from other players to avoid collisions.
- 2. Arena Boundaries:**
 - Stay within the designated play area.
 - Do not climb on or over barriers, obstacles, or arena structures.
- 3. No Obstructing Paths:**
 - Do not block paths, doorways, or exits.
- 4. No Hazardous Behavior:**
 - No sliding, jumping, or any behavior that could lead to injury.
- 5. Health and Safety:**
 - Players with health conditions such as heart issues, epilepsy, or pregnancy should consult with a doctor before playing.
 - If you feel unwell or injured, leave the arena immediately and inform a staff member.

Game Rules:

- 1. Gameplay Objective:**
 - The objective is to score points by tagging opponents and hitting targets within the arena.
 - Players are divided into teams or play individually, depending on the game mode.
- 2. Tagging Rules:**

- Aim for the opponent's headband sensors or front to score points.
- Each player has a limited number of lives or ammo, depending on the game mode.
- 3. **Re-spawning:**
 - If tagged out, follow the re-spawning rules as instructed by the game mode. This usually involves waiting for a few seconds before re-entering the game.
- 4. **Scorekeeping:**
 - Scores are tracked automatically by the equipment and displayed at the end of the game.
- 5. **Fair Play:**
 - No cheating or unfair play, such as covering sensors or deliberately obstructing equipment.

Code of Conduct:

1. **Respect:**
 - Treat all players, staff, and visitors with respect.
 - Use appropriate language and behavior at all times.
2. **Listening to Staff:**
 - Follow all instructions and safety guidelines provided by the staff.
 - Report any issues or concerns to the staff immediately.
3. **No Intimidation or Harassment:**
 - Bullying, intimidation, or harassment of any kind is strictly prohibited.
4. **Personal Belongings:**
 - Keep track of your personal belongings. The arena is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
5. **Cleanliness:**
 - Dispose of trash in designated bins.
 - Keep the arena and waiting areas clean and tidy.
6. **Food and Drinks:**
 - No food or drinks are allowed inside the arena.
 - Designated areas for eating and drinking are provided outside the play area.

Consequences for Rule Violations:

1. **Warnings:**
 - Players may receive a verbal warning for minor infractions.
2. **Temporary Suspension:**
 - Repeated or serious violations may result in temporary suspension from the game or the facility.
3. **Permanent Ban:**
 - Severe or repeated violations may lead to a permanent ban from the facility.
4. **Liability:**
 - Players are responsible for any damage to equipment or the facility resulting from rule violations.
